

hear our prayer.



give thanks and praise to you, almighty and merciful God.


You reveal your glory as the glory of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit: equal in majesty, undivided in splendor, one Lord, one God,

Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us:


