On the Cover...

The marking of neighborhoods by the City of Sandusky finally reached the former Village of Venice by mid-November. The pictured marker stands at the main intersection of the village: Venice Road and Fremont Avenue. Trinity Congregation memorialized the village some years ago by funding an Erie County Historical Society marker erected near this same corner. At the dedication ceremony, Sonny Schonhardt quipped that there were more people there at the celebration than ever lived in Venice.

The village was annexed into the City of Sandusky in 1964. Margaritaville sits on the site of the old mill that was the mainstay of Venice for more than a century before it was shut down in 1945. The mill race remains, flowing with warm spring water from near Castalia. The water almost never froze, keeping the mill in operation almost year-round.

The old town hall is now an apartment building. It stands across from Margaritaville's extended parking lot. The hall is where Zion, Sandusky, began Sunday afternoon Bible classes in the late 1800's. Those in attendance encouraged Zion to build a Venice Chapel at 502 Bardshar Road, starting in the fall of 1913. The building was dedicated in May of 1914. Trinity became a congregation on its own on February 2, 1926. Our congregation will mark its 94th anniversary early next month.

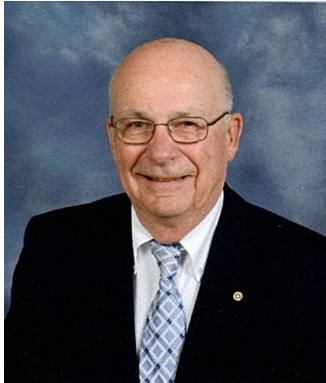

MEET YOUR NEW INTERIM PASTORS



Pastor Ralph was born in Canton, Ohio in 1935. In 1953, he graduated from Youngstown South High School. He attended the University of Pennsylvania until 1955 when he transferred to Thiel College in Greenville, Pa. He graduated from Thiel in 1958. He graduated from Hamma School of Theology, Wittenberg University in Springfield, Ohio in 1962. He was ordained at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Greenville, Pa. He earned his Doctor in Theology from Ashland Theological Seminary, Ashland, Ohio in 1978.

On May 23, 1959, he married Patricia (Pat) McDermott in Turtle Creek, Pa. They have 4 daughters, 9 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren .

Since ordination, Pastor has served as Assistant Pastor at Zion Lutheran Church, Canton, Ohio for 5 years. He then served as Mission Redeveloper and Pastor at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Brunswick, Ohio for 15 years. He then served as Pastor at St. Mark Lutheran Church, Brunswick, Ohio for 20 years. While in Brunswick he also taught History of World Religions at Lutheran School of Allied Health Professions for 10 years. He also monitored 7 Interns.

Pastor Ralph and Pat moved to Catawba Island upon retirement.

Pastor Ralph is also active in Rotary and served as District Governor in the year 2007-2008. He continues to be active in the Rotary Club of Port Clinton.

Since retirement, Pastor Ralph has served as Interim Pastor in numerous congregations.



Grace and peace to you from our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Hello! My name is Cathy Schibler-Keegan but please feel free to call me Pastor Cathy or Pastor Schibler. I am married to Clayton Keegan, who farms full time and we have three children: Meredith, Sarah & Jacob.

I grew up in Brunswick Ohio and was a marching Blue Devil playing flute and piccolo. From there I went to Wittenberg University and graduated with a BA in Political Science and English. I had never anticipated becoming a pastor but the Holy Spirit kept nudging and pushing toward Word and Sacrament ministry. I attended Trinity Lutheran Seminary in Columbus Ohio and have been ordained for 32 years.

My first call was to Good Shepherd in Vickery, Ohio. After serving nine years, I was called to the bishop's staff of the Northwestern Ohio Synod and served for 18 years working with candidates for ministry and with congregations in the call process or conflict. After Bishop Lohrmann retired, churchwide called me to serve at Portico Benefits, the ELCA organization that provides health benefits and retirement for our rostered ministers. I also get to sit on the Board of Directors for Wittenberg University. This will be my fourth interim serving with my dad, Pastor Ralph Schibler.

My prayer during this interim period is to help keep us focused on the cross of Jesus and to help discern how the Holy Spirit is moving as you enter into a new segment of ministry.

COUNCIL UPDATE

TRINITY CONGREGATION COUNCIL Meeting Highlights - December 19, 2019 - 7:00 pm (These are unapproved meeting minutes)

Meeting called to order by President, Dave Miller. Devotions were given by Jim Bertsch.

Minutes of previous meeting (November 7) were reviewed. Motion made by Sally to except the minutes as submitted. 2nd by Barb. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report for November was reviewed. Sally made a motion to move \$10,000 from the checking account into the Thrivent Bond checking account to earn some additional interest. 2nd by Barb. Motion passed. Jim stated that a good size branch had fallen and landed a portion of the parsonage garage. Jim had Ronnie VanZandt come and clean up the branch and trim two trees on the property to prevent any further damage. Ronnie charged \$825 for everything. A motion to approve the Treasurer's reports was made by Barb. 2nd by Judy. Motion passed.

President's Report: Dave is in the process of meeting with employees for their reviews. Dave talked to John Miller about the wheelchair ramp at his house for Braxton. John will give Dave a balance due on the bill for its installation. Dave will get with the volunteer to see about providing the \$750 balance due. It was acknowledged that council received a copy of the Congregational meeting minutes from November 10.

Pastor's Report: Pastor presented the following people as new members here at Trinity: James and Nancy Yantz, by transfer from St Paul, Sandusky; Millie McCready, awaiting transfer from St Paul, Sandusky; Karen Michaels and Christopher Michaels, by transfer from First Congregational United Church of Christ, Sandusky; Maryl Bango, by affirmation of faith. Barb made a motion to receive these new members at the December 22 services. 2nd by Sally. Motion passed. Pastor informed the council he has purchased additional copies of "A Field Guide for the Missional Congregation" recommended reading by Bishop Beaudoin.

The Congregational Care Ministry team – A preliminary emergency pastoral care sheet was distributed. Will be finalized before Pastor Gardner's leaving.

Faith Builders – Barb Wobser – The Christmas program went well again this year.

Mission Service – Judy Driscoll – The pork and sauerkraut dinner went well. They will be meeting again in February.

Property – Vacant – Suggestions were made that there be a door stop added to the south entry door that maybe could hang from the overhang that is there. This would keep the ground free from anything to trip over. What would be the cost of adding wheelchair push button door openers for the elevator entrance? The door there is very heavy and there isn't always someone around to help open it for those who need to use that entrance.

Worship and Music – Daniel Schlick – Hymns were picked through March. Pastors Ralph and Cathy will select the Hymn of the Day each week. We are using setting 3 from the cranberry book for 2020. Pastor Gardner did work ahead into January of 2020 to help Carol get the bulletins standardized for the new year.

New Business – Dave volunteered to be the January 2020 devotions leader and Barb was already set to be the money counter until the January meeting. Two facility use forms were approved. Daniel Schlick continues on with the Diakonia program. He has 3 or 4 more classes at \$60 per class. Barb Wobser will be Carol's contact person if she is unable to get to work for any reason. All Carol's exceptions to the 9 to 1 work day are listed on the calendar in the church office. Sally asked that she be allowed to spend some of Robert Sessler's memorial money on the purchase of two new Christmas trees for the sanctuary. Council approved.

Prior to the council meeting Judy made a motion that a \$500 gift card to Corso's be purchased as a gift to Pastor Gardner for the council and congregation. 2nd by Barb. Motion passed.
