

cake and Diet Coke or popcorn and movies) remember why.



#### TRINITY CONGREGATION COUNCIL Meeting Highlights - March 21, 2024 - 7:00 pm

Meeting called to order by President - Carrie Wiedenheft

Opening devotions were given by Betsy Stierhoff

Minutes of previous meeting (February 2024) were reviewed. Jim made a motion to accept the January meeting minutes. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Barb. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report for February 2024 was reviewed. Betsy made a motion to accept the February treasurer's report. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Barb. Motion passed.

President's Report: Carrie passed out reviews/comments from papers everyone filled out in January/February. The minutes from the congregational meeting on March 17 were reviewed. Carol needs to change out an incorrect member name on the report.

Pastor's Report: Lenten Services are going well on both Tuesday evening and Wednesday morning. P. Jen may look into doing a Sermon Series this summer. She will be working with Gayle to do some more home visits. Confirmation is set for May 19 with 3 possibly 4 kids being confirmed. P. Jen went with Kathy B. to Compass Point earlier that day. They learned more about what they do there. They currently have 8 people with the compacity for 40. They are working on getting transportation to help get more individuals there. P. Jen will be on vacation for a few days after Easter. She asked that you please let her know if you are having meetings, so she is aware of what is going on within the church. Also, let Carol know so the calendar can be checked for conflicts.

Congregational Life – Kathy Bango – P. Jen reported that the March 5, Tuesday evening meal at Zion went fine. Kathy only had to bring desserts, everything else was already provided.

Faith Builders – Pat Wiedenheft – There will be a youth sleepover on Maundy Thursday evening. Sally, Shelby, and Carrie K. will be the adults attending. There will be a meeting between services on Sunday about the sleepover.

Community Mission – Betsy Stierhoff – Betsy's group will meet April 7 between services to brainstorm ideas for their group.

Property – Bill Bertsch – The downstair fellowship area is finished besides putting some baseboard up and a couple of doors. The congregation approved up to \$15,000 for a garage door opener for the parsonage, to fix the leak on the parsonage porch roof, and to replace the rotted basement window. Bill will work on getting these done. Bill made a motion to accept the two bids from Gundlach: One for our yearly maintenance with them for the parsonage and church boilers, AC units, and furnaces, for \$1,473.00 per year. Second was for replacing the air compressor on the church boiler system, for \$6,592.43. Money to come from the Building Improvement fund. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pat. Motion passed. Bill will give Rex a call about someone he knows who could do the parsonage garage door at a reasonable rate. It was noted that it should be checked that quotes on the parsonage are for residential work not commercial.

Worship and Music – Nancy Vollmer/Barb Sessler – Their next meeting is April 3 at 1 pm. The newly approved communion schedule will start the Sunday after Easter. They will be discussing music options in the future.

Young at Heart – April 17 at 1 pm will be the painting class. Cost is \$15. They received a Thank You note from Compass Point for the Valentine's cookies.

New Business – Pat will see if Carrie K. has pictures of P. Ralph and Cathy that can be hung in the church office. P. Jen will work on getting a picture of herself also. P. Jen will talk with Kathy B. about a new directory. They have discussed doing one in 2025 so it is ready for Trinity's Centennial in February 2026.



\* Timings for the beginning & end of partial eclipse, the beginning & end of totality, and maximum eclipse are accurate to within a few seconds. This calculation uses a Delta T value of 69.22 seconds.

Timings for other events are approximate—they are included here as a rough guide to features that might be observable. The icons show the position of the Moon against the Sun at each stage, but they do not show the correct position of the diamond ring and Baily's beads.
