

COUNCIL UPDATE

TRINITY CONGREGATION COUNCIL Meeting Highlights - October 10, 2024 - 7:00 pm

(These are unapproved meeting minutes)

Attending: Pat Wiedenheft, Jim Bertsch, P. Jen, Carrie Wiedenheft, Barb Sessler, Bill Bertsch, Nancy Vollmer, Gayle Thompson and Secretary Carol Dahs Absent: Kathy Bango and Betsy Stierhoff

Meeting called to order by President – Carrie Wiedenheft Opening devotions were given by Carrie Wiedenheft

Minutes of previous meeting (September 2024) were reviewed. Bill made a motion to accept the September meeting minutes 2^{nd} by Barb S. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report for September was not available for review.

President's Report: Carrie reviewed the Congregational meeting agenda. The date for item number III should be 2023 not 2024. Under item IV, item D. Charity Fund needs to be added and under items IX, item B. Secretary Position needs to be added. Nancy made a motion to approve the agenda with the noted corrections. 2nd Barb S. Motion passed. Cookies will be made for between services and Gayle will check with Kathy Bango on whether or not she wants to run for Congregation Life Chair again next year. The Election Ballot was reviewed. Pat made a motion to accept the ballot with the understanding it may need to be updated with the removal of Kathy Bango if she chooses not to run again in 2025. 2nd by Nancy. Motion passed.

Pastor's Report: P. Jen is continuing with hospital and care center visitations. The high school youth will be doing fundraisers throughout the next couple of years to raise funds for the 2027 Youth Gathering. This is open to 6th through 10th grade students as of this year. Some of the fundraisers being looked at are partnering with Texas Roadhouse for a night of receiving part of purchases made when accompanied with a coupon, pop up bake sales, etc. Couches and chairs were moved into the new high school classroom and some painting will be done yet. P. Jen is working on getting an adult bible study session going.

Faith Builders – Pat Wiedenheft – Sunday school has started. October 27th will be trunk or treat for the youth between services.

Community Mission – Jim Reported for Betsy – The chili cookoff has been set for November 3 after the second service. The signup sheet for cooks is up and has some contestants listed. There is no charge for the event, but donations will be accepted. There will be a \$50 gift card for the winning chili. The Community Mission team will provide cheese, crackers and brownies for the event. Jim will deliver the 115 health care kits on October 12.

Property – Bill Bertsch – New address numbers are on the mailbox now. The yellow strip on the back stairs has been repainted. Bill is in conversation with Joe Bodie on the parsonage basement window. Sandusky Door and Hearth installed the new parsonage garage door opener at a cost of \$414. The City of Sandusky is looking for some information on our water line. Mike M. took care of hanging pictures at the parsonage and fixed the bathroom light. The front pew needs to be looked at yet.

Stewardship & Finance – Jim Bertsch - We have a CD coming do October 23 for \$1,909.83. Jim made a motion to renew the CD at a rate of 4.62% for another year. 2nd by Pat. Motion passed. Jim reviewed the 2025 budget. P. Jen's salary has increased because the Synod is trying to catch up with the rest of the state on wages. Staff will receive a 3% increase. Barb made a motion to accept the 2025 budget as presented. 2nd by Gayle. Motion passed. Jim reviewed the 2025 Proposed Charity Fund distribution recommendations. Jim made a motion to accept the proposal with the notation that the Holy Angels Thanksgiving support is for the bag of food they give with every meal. 2nd by Nancy. Motion passed. Jim reviewed the 2025 Proposed Endowment Fund distribution. Jim made a motion to accept the proposal with the addition of Hurricane Milton being added to Hurricane Helene. 2nd by Barb. Motion passed.

Worship and Music – Nancy Vollmer/Barb Sessler – The 2025 usher schedule is done and will be given to Carol.

Young at Heart – Nancy Vollmer – In November they are going to see a harlequin play "Cheaters". Signup is on the bulletin board. December they will be going to the Senior Center. In February they are looking at decoration cookies again for Valentine's Day and having a luncheon in April.

Old Business – Barb S & Bonnie L. are in process of getting the new picture frames.

New Business – Carol has decided she will be moving on from Trinity. P. Jen reviewed an updated job description for the secretary position. Pat made a motion to accept the updated job description with the addition under Hours and Schedule to include having to attend Congregational yearly and special meeting. 2nd by Bill. Motion passed. P. Jen will see about posting the job on Indeed and to our Facebook page. The job will be offered at \$17.00/hour (\$18,200/year) to start. P. Jen, Bill and hopefully Kathy B will sit on the interviewing board.




